

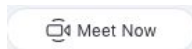
Generation Z Online Tutoring


With COVID-19 forcing the closure of libraries and schools, Generation Z tutors are going to be providing online tutoring to continue helping students learn and grow academically. There will be two online platforms we will be utilizing to make this happen: Skype and Zoom.

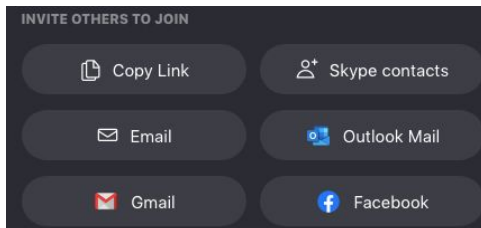


To get tutoring help with Skype:

1. Download the app on any device by scanning the QR code on the right or going to <https://www.skype.com/en/get-skype/>.
2. Sign in or create a new account with Skype. Make sure to not use your child's school account. Use your personal information. Let Skype access the camera, microphone, and contacts on your device.
3. To create a new call with your tutor, click the meet now button



on your home page. Invite your tutor to join the call by using anything of the methods shown. Start the call  and wait for your tutor to join.



4. To make this process even easier, **skip steps 1-3**. Get your tutor to create a call and send the meeting link to you, and you don't even have to have a Skype account to join!

2. Sign in or create a new account with Zoom. Make sure to not use your child's school account. Use your personal information. Let Zoom access the camera, microphone, and contacts on your device.

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3. To create a new meeting with your tutor, click the new meeting button.
